# Lessons Identified



- Different levels of national activation and measures *“east west gap”*
- Simplification of procedures for ad hoc movements of larger formations
- Movements based on different procedures (NATO, EU CBMP TA, EU BCTS and bi-national agreements)
- Minor actions happened already before 24th Feb 2022 (CRM)
- Exemptions mainly for movements in context to UKR spt
- Different rules for military movements under national, multinational or CSO command.
- Benefit of established bi-national cooperation (e.g. DEU & NLD Military Mobility office)
- Extension of bi-lateral cooperation (LOI for NLD-DEU-POL harmonized Corridor)





# Actions to be taken...



- Enhanced EU – NATO cooperation
- Definition of an “in between state” between peacetime and crisis
- Harmonized CBM-regulations and procedures
- Reduction of national documentation and caveats
- Establishment of Information Exchange Systems
- Adjustment of the National Plans for Military Mobility
- Validation of processes via ad hoc LIVEX or TTX
- “Keep the MOMENTUM – don’t loose it”
