To answer all these questions, we will have the pleasure of welcoming Mr Camille Grand, researcher at the European Council on Foreign Relations (ECFR) and former NATO Assistant Secretary General, as well as Mr Sven Arnold, guest researcher at the German Institute for International and Security Affairs (Stiftung Wissenschaft und Politik, SWP) in Berlin.

This conference will take place <u>in French</u> on Thursday 22 May 2025 at 17:00 <u>in the conference room</u> at campus Renaissance (entrance: rue Hobbema 8/Hobbemastraat 8, 1000 Brussels). <u>A simultaneous interpretation in English and Dutch will be provided in the conference room</u>.
